


This issue presents data on Colorado restaurant sales for the second quarter 2004. Sales are presented for each of the seven Denver metro area counties; El Paso, Larimer, Pueblo, and Weld counties; and sales by restaurants in the rest of the State. For comparison, restaurant sales for the United States as a whole are also shown for the same time period. Data in this report represent sales by businesses whose primary activity is food preparation for on-premise consumption.

The data show that Colorado restaurant industry sales in the second quarter 2004 increased 6.6 percent, to about \$1.53 billion, over second quarter last year. Sales for the entire United States increased 10.4 percent, to \$442.4 billion, over the same period. As shown on the next page, Weld County experienced the largest increase at 17.5 percent. All of the counties reviewed showed an increase over last year.
